Thank you for your interest in affordable housing in New Providence. The Borough administers 41 affordable housing units. Application forms will be available on the Borough's website, www.newprov.org when the Borough begins its next open application period. The dates of the application period will be advertised on the website and in the Newark *Star Ledger*. We regret that applications cannot be accepted at any other time.

After the application period closes, every application submitted is placed into a lottery. Names are drawn and are assigned the next position on the waiting list for the appropriate type of unit for that applicant (1 Bedroom Low-Income, 2 Bedroom Low-Income, etc.).

The Borough rarely has a vacancy, so you may wish to contact other towns' Affordable Housing offices or check the NJ Affordable Housing website for a listing of available units elsewhere. The State's website is <http://www.njhrc.gov/>. Click on "Find Housing", then on the next screen, choose "Rentals" or "For Sale", depending on your needs. On the following screen you will see a list of all the counties in New Jersey and under each county, the towns that have units available. To obtain details about applying for any of these units, follow the posted instructions, go to the town's website or call the town's Affordable Housing office. Availability can change quickly, so we recommend you check this site often.

Income limits are determined by the NJ Council on Affordable Housing and vary by region. Our housing units are located in Region #2, which includes the counties of Essex, Morris, Union and Warren. Income limits may change from year to year and depend upon the number of persons in the household. The current income limits are shown on the next page.

Please feel free to contact our office at any time to check on the timing of the Borough's application process.

We wish we had enough affordable housing for all. Good luck in your search!
