Rules & Regulations

Hours

- All eight courts are open daily for New Providence residents and non-residents.
- All eight courts are lit in the evenings, as follows:

SPRING & FALL

Weekdays: Dusk till 9:00PM

Weekends: Dusk till 10:00PM

SUMMER

Daily: Dusk till 10:00PM

Rules for Playing Tennis

- Borough/BOE-sponsored programs take precedence over all other play.
- Permit holders have court priority. If all courts are being used, non-permit holders must vacate their court if requested by a permit holder.
- No paid or unpaid group lessons are permitted on courts except those sponsored by the Borough's Recreation Department
- All play is restricted to one hour for singles and doubles, when other players are waiting to play.
- A court must be occupied by a minimum of two players and no more than four players (doubles), with the exception of Borough-sponsored activities.

Rules for Court Usage – All Times

- No food or beverages
- No glass containers
- No pets
- Trash is to be placed in the provided containers.
- No game other than tennis is to be played on the courts.
- Persons not playing tennis are to remain outside the fence for their own protection.
- Excessive noise, racket throwing, and profanity are strictly forbidden.
- The Borough has the right to eject any player for failure to comply with any of the aforementioned rules.
