Class Descriptions

MUSICAL THEATRE (Grades 4-5): Beginning with theatre games and improvisation, students will work on basic acting skills in a supportive, creative and fun and environment. Students will also learn how to incorporate acting skills and movement into songs. Throughout the year, students will apply these skills by rehearsing for and performing in a production of *Winnie the Pooh, Kids* on Saturday March 11. There is a mandatory dress rehearsal for both classes on Friday, March 10 from 6:30-8:30 pm. *Students must be able to attend the dress rehearsal and both performances on March 11 in order to participate.* Each class size is limited to 12 students. Instructor/Director: Sandra Nissen; Musical Director: Alex Ratner. *Location: Municipal Center, Room G-2.*

6th GRADE PLAY (Grade 6): By using more advanced theatre games and improvisation work, students will learn and enhance their acting skills in a supportive, creative and fun and environment. Throughout the year, students will apply these skills by rehearsing for and performing in a production of *You Ain't Nothin' but a Werewolf* on Saturday, April 8 and Sunday, April 9. There are mandatory dress rehearsals on Thursday, April 6th from 6:00-8:30 pm and Friday, April 7th from 6:30-9:00 pm. Students must be able to attend both dress rehearsals and both performances in order to participate. Class size is limited to 16 students. Instructor/Director: Sandra Nissen; Set design: Sean Puzzo. *Location: Municipal Center, Room G-2.*

MIDDLE SCHOOL MUSICAL THEATRE WORKSHOP (Grades 7-8): Students will refine their acting skills through theatre games and improvisation and learn all aspects of putting on a musical, including auditioning, acting, singing, and dance in a supportive, creative, and fun and environment.. The class will culminate in a production of *Willy Wonka, Jr.* on Saturday, April 29 at 7:00pm and Sunday, April 30 at 2:00pm. **There are mandatory dress rehearsals on Monday, April 24, from 3:15-5:00, Thursday, April 27 from 4:30-7:30 and Friday April 28 from 3:15-6:00. Students must be able to attend all dress rehearsals and performances in order to participate.** Class size is limited to 20 students. Instructor/Director: Sandra Nissen; Musical Director: Alex Ratner; Choreographer: Jessica Lombardi; Sean Puzzo: Set Designer. *Location: Municipal Center, Room G-2.*
