



2010 TENNIS COURT RULES & REGULATIONS

Hours

1. All courts are open daily from 8:00AM-6:00PM for New Providence residents and non-residents.
2. The 4 lit courts are reserved for permit holders and their guests in the evenings from 6:00-10:00PM from May 28 through September 6.

Rules for Playing Tennis - At All Times

1. Borough/BOE-sponsored programs, whether tennis or otherwise, take precedence over all other play.
2. No paid or unpaid group lessons are permitted on courts except those sponsored by the Borough's Recreation Department.
3. All play is restricted to one hour for singles and doubles, when other players are waiting to play.
4. A court must be occupied by a minimum of two players and no more than four players (doubles), with the exception of Borough-sponsored activities.
5. Wait until play is finished before walking across a court to get to your court. Be prompt in sending back any stray tennis balls from adjacent courts. Do not leave empty tins, tin tops, plastic waste or other refuse on the courts. Finish on time and close the gate when entering and leaving.

Rules for Court Usage – At All Times

1. No food or beverages, other than water or sports drinks, are permitted on the courts.
2. Glass containers are prohibited on the courts.
3. Trash is to be placed in the provided containers.
4. Smoking is prohibited on the courts.
5. No game other than tennis is to be played on the courts.
6. Excessive noise, racquet throwing, and profanity is strictly forbidden.
7. Persons not playing tennis are to remain outside the fence for their own protection.
8. Pets are not permitted on the courts at any time.
9. The Borough has the right to eject any player for failure to comply with any of the aforementioned rules.

Rules for 6:00-10:00PM Daily for the 4 Lit Courts Only (additional rules apply to permit holders)

1. Permits are required and must be presented to court attendants upon request.
2. Court reservations may be made online and receive precedence.
3. Guests may play on the lit courts provided they are accompanied by a permit holder and pay the appropriate guest fee.
4. The Borough has the right to revoke any permit for failure to comply with any of the aforementioned rules.
