Who Should Get the Flu Shot?

EVERYONE! The flu shot is recommended for everyone who is over 6 months of age. Remember, you should get the flu shot **EACH YEAR**, as the types of virus that can circulate may change.



Remember, it can take up to 2 weeks for the flu shot to fully protect you from the flu virus. Get your vaccine as soon as possible.
