10-13-2010 - Patrolman Andrew Diamond charged Alicia Bronski, 32, of Scotch Plains with driving while intoxicated after she was observed driving carelessly on South Street. Ms. Bronski was released to a family member with a pending court date.

10-13-2010 – Patrolman Chad Wilson arrested Joseph Cora, 42, of Elizabeth for an outstanding warrant from Newark. Mr. Cora was stopped for several equipment violations on Springfield Avenue.

10-13-2010 – Patrolman Chad Wilson charged Patrick Drake, 18, of Basking Ridge with defiant trespass and underage possession of alcohol. The charges stem from Patrolman Wilson investigating a report of two individuals attempting to stop passing vehicles on Union Avenue.
