Press release September 21, 2010

8-26-2010- Detective Bubba charged Lauren Hodges age 20 of North Plainfield with seven counts of theft after an investigation revealed that Ms. Hodges was stealing from customers at a New Providence doctor's office.

9-14-2010- Patrolman DiParisi arrested Amar K. Dixon age 26 of Plainfield for an active warrant out of East Orange. The arrest came from a Pedestrian Crossing detail and Mr. Dixon was stopped for failing to yield to the Police Pedestrian Decoy. Mr. Dixon satisfied the warrant.
