12-02-2010: A visiting shopper to the borough reported her wallet was stolen outside of a business in town. The suspect then made several fraudulent charges to one of the victim's credit cards. The credit card fraud and theft are being investigated by the New Providence Detective Bureau.

12-03-2010: New Jersey Transit reported a hit and run crash that occurred at the railroad crossing of Livingston Avenue and Central Avenue. The suspect vehicle struck the railroad gate and then left the scene. The crash is currently under investigation and anyone who has any information on the incident is asked to contact the New Providence Detective Bureau.

12-06-2010: Patrolman Diamond charged Jempsley Brun, age 25, of Orange with operating a vehicle with a suspended registration and no insurance after his vehicle was stopped for an equipment violation. The owner of the vehicle, Romainson Romain, age 23, of Union was charged with allowing the operation of a vehicle with a suspended registration and no insurance, cracked windshield, and refusal to inspect the vehicle. Both parties were given a mandatory court date.

12-07-2010: A student of the New Providence High School reported her I-pod Touch was stolen from a classroom. The matter is being investigated by the New Providence Detective Bureau.

12-07-2010: Patrolman Diamond arrested David G. Halek, age 56, of New Providence with driving while impaired and speeding after his vehicle was stopped for speeding. Mr. Halek was released to a family member pending a court date.

12-08-2010: Sergeant Gaffney arrested David Branch, age 55, of Newark on an outstanding warrant out of Newark. Mr. Branch was released after posting bail.

12-09-2010: Patrolman Diamond took a New Providence juvenile into protective custody and charged him with possession of marijuana under 50 grams, possession of drug paraphernalia, and failure to deliver CDS to the nearest law enforcement officer after his vehicle was stopped for a motor vehicle violation. He was also charged with driving while suspended, unlicensed driver, operating a vehicle while in possession of CDS, and taking a vehicle without the owner's consent. The juvenile was released to his parent and given court dates for the charges.

12-09-2010: Corporal Henn arrested William DeRose, age 48, of Millington with driving while intoxicated after an investigation was completed into a motor vehicle crash. Mr. DeRose was charged with driving while intoxicated, refusal to submit to a breath test, and careless driving. He was released to a family member pending a court date.
