SERGEANT JUSTINE KENNEDY:

With the new school year about to begin, the New Providence Police Department would like to remind parents of some important state and borough regulations regarding parking around the schools.

- No parking on or within 25 feet of a crosswalk
- No parking within 50 feet of a stop sign
- No parking within 10 feet of a fire hydrant
- No parking in front of a public or private driveway

All Borough Ordinance parking regulations are posted by signs

No parking on Pioneer Drive, either side

Limited time parking on William Street & James Street, as well as portions of High Street & Providence Street

No stopping or standing on the school side of Providence Street

No stopping or standing on Jones Drive on the side opposite the school

No stopping or standing on Maple Street from the exit driveway to Springfield Avenue

No stopping or standing on Maple Street approximately 50 feet south of the exit driveway from the school

No stopping or standing on Maple Street opposite the school during drop off & pick-up times

No stopping or standing on the east side of Willow Street and south of the board of education fence.

No stopping or standing on portions of Brookside Drive, Midvale Drive & Glenbrook Road

There is also no left turn allowed from Willow Street onto Springfield Avenue during drop off and pick-up times.

The Police Department asks for the cooperation of all parents to ensure the safety of our school children. Compliance with parking regulations can avoid officers having to issue summonses. Remember, there is no "grace period" for parking regulations. Please help us make the school year a safe one.
