January 7, 2011 Press Release

12-21-2010 – Patrolman Joseph DiParisi charged Ian Gammon, 21, of South Orange with possession of marijuana, drug paraphernalia and several motor vehicle summonses including operating a motor vehicle while his license was suspended. Corporal Dennis Carovillano charged Leshon Hill, 20, of Orangeburg, New York with illegal possession of a prescription medication. Mr. Hill also had outstanding warrants from Palisades Parkway Court. These charges stem from the officers locating a vehicle parked in a Mountain Avenue business parking lot at 2:22 am. As officers approached the vehicle, the vehicle attempted to pull away. Mr. Gammon was released on his own recognizance with a pending court date. Mr. Hill was released on \$7500.00 bail.
