5-6-2011 – Patrols charged Michael Tredici, 18, of Colonia for underage possession and consumption of alcohol. Four juveniles were also placed into custody and were charged for underage possession and consumption of alcohol. The charges arise from a citizen complaint of the group causing a disturbance at an organized function on Springfield Avenue. All involved were released to their parents with pending court dates.

5-8-2011 – Patrols recovered an unoccupied, stolen motor vehicle, at a Springfield Avenue business that had been reported stolen out of Union City in October of 2009.

5-9-2011 – Sergeant Justine Kennedy charged Jacinta Meza, 52, of Neshanic Station for operating a motor vehicle while her driver's license was suspended. Ms. Meza was stopped on Mountain Avenue for equipment violations. She was released with a pending court date.
