Press Release 8-23-11

8-17-2011 - A 17 year old Borough resident reported that while he was walking on South Street at 9:20 PM, a black pickup truck pulled up behind him and the passenger began to spray him with "silly string" spray. The victim described the pick up truck as being a GMC. As the truck began to pull away, the victim reported that someone from the vehicle shot him with what he thought was a bb or pellet gun four times. The incident was reported to the police department on 8-18-2011 and the case is being investigated by the Detective Bureau. 8-19-2011 – Several pieces of park equipment were damaged by graffiti at Jaycee Park and Lyon's Park sometime during the night.

8-20-2011 – Corporal Daniel Henn charged Colin Price, 26, of Berkeley Heights with driving while intoxicated and refusal to submit to breath tests. Corporal Henn observed Mr. Price traveling at a speed that he estimated to be 100 miles per hour, traveling westbound on Mountain Avenue at 3:07 am. While Corporal Henn was watching the speeding vehicle, the vehicle proceeded to travel through red lights at Mountain Avenue and Ryder Way and Diamond Hill Road and Mountain Avenue. Patrols were able to conduct a motor vehicle stop with Mr. Price in Berkeley Heights on Roosevelt Avenue. Mr. Price was also charged with failing to observe traffic light, reckless driving and failing to produce his registration and insurance cards.

8-20-2011 – Detective Sretenovic arrested Lenny Ojeda, 36, of Edison on an outstanding child support warrant from the Union County Sheriff's Department on Mountain Avenue during a motor vehicle stop. Mr. Ojeda was also charged with operating a vehicle with a suspended driver's license. Mr. Ojeda was turned over to the Sheriff's Department.

8-20-2011 – Patrols and Detectives responded to the American Legion on Elkwood Avenue on the report of a burglary. Members reported that an exterior door was pried open. Once entry was gained, a locked office door and a safe was pried open. Detectives are investigating the report.

8-22-2011 – Patrols and Detectives responded to a reported burglary to a residence on Mountain Avenue. Upon arrival, patrols observed a pane of glass broken out from the window. The bedrooms of the home were ransacked with jewelry, money and several other valuables taken. Detectives have been investigating several leads that they have received.
