## ***Press Release: November 16, 2011***

10-18-2011- Detective Donald Sretenovic arrested Bryan Dungee, age 23, of Newark with Theft by Deception after an investigation was conducted into a theft, deposit, and withdrawal of stolen checks. Mr. Dungee was released pending a court date.

11-11-2011- Patrols have taken reports of property being damaged by graffiti, at numerous locations throughout the Borough. The locations have been Our Lady of Peace Church walls, the New Providence High School walls, several businesses and roadways. The Police Department has received more video surveillance from one of the locations and is continuing the investigation into these and previous incidents of graffiti.
