3-31-2011 – Sergeant Frank Gaffney arrested Renato Gallosa, 36, of Elizabeth for an outstanding warrant out of Saddle River. Mr. Gallosa was stopped for motor vehicle violations on Springfield Avenue. He was released after posting bail.

4-3-2011 –The New Providence Police and the New Providence Fire Department responded to a house fire on Runnymede Parkway. The fire spread from the chimney where the resident was burning wood to the surrounding structure of the residence. The fire was quickly extinguished by the fire department.
