Press Release 9-7-2011

8-22-2011 – A residence was reported burglarized on Mountain Avenue between 12:00 PM and 12:28 PM. Entry to the residence was gained by breaking the glass on the front door. Jewelry, coins and several other valuables were removed from the residence. Detectives responded to process the burglary and are investigating this report. A witness in the area reported seeing a silver or grey SUV, possibly a Dodge Durango, leaving the driveway during this time frame. The driver of the vehicle is described as a bald, white male in his 50's. Anyone that may have witnessed this burglary is asked to contact the New Providence Police at 908-665-1111.

8-23-2011 – Patrolman Andrew Diamond charged Scott Dayson, 44, of Columbia with driving while intoxicated, possession of a controlled dangerous substance, possession of drug paraphernalia, hindering apprehension, driving while suspended, failure to report a motor vehicle accident, leaving the scene of a motor vehicle accident and reckless driving. The charges stem from Mr. Dayson crashing into a fire hydrant and causing damage to the lawn of a residence of Union Avenue by Fairview Avenue. Mr. Dayson also had an outstanding warrant from Hope Township Municipal Court.

8-25-2011 – Patrolman Andrew Diamond arrested Abdoulaye Diallo, 33, of Bayonne on an outstanding warrant out of Bayonne on Diamond Hill Road. Mr. Diallo was also charged with driving while suspended, operating a motor vehicle without insurance and failure to inspect his vehicle.

8-26-2011 – Patrolman Chad Wilson took three juvenile females into protective custody after a motor vehicle stop on Maple Street. The 17-year-old driver was charged with violating her provisional driver's license, possession of a controlled dangerous substance in a motor vehicle and possession of an open alcohol container. A 15-year-old female was charged with possession of drug paraphernalia that contained the residue of a controlled dangerous substance. All juveniles were released to their parents with pending court dates.

8-27-2011 – Patrolman Michael Scruorzo arrested Maksim Chudayeu, 43, of New Providence with driving while intoxicated and possession of an open alcohol container in his vehicle. Police received a complaint from a concerned citizen that Mr. Chudayeu was sitting in his vehicle in a parking lot on Springfield Avenue and appeared to be ill. Patrols located two empty vodka bottles and an empty beer can on his passenger seat.

9-1-2011 – Detective Donald Sretenovic charged Elenyi Enamorado, 23, of Summit with shoplifting. These charges stem from Ms. Enamorado taking beauty supply merchandise from a Springfield Avenue business on 8-23-2011.

9-1-2011 – A contractor working on a residence on Madison Avenue reported the theft of copper and plumbing tools from a driveway where his company was working.

9-1-2011 – A resident of Timothy Field Road reported that someone had damaged a glass windowpane to their residence by throwing an object at the window.

9-4-2011 – A resident of Martin's Lane reported that someone had attempted to gain entry to his 2007 BMW that was parked in his driveway by trying to pry the driver's side door open. Evidence was recovered from the scene and detectives are investigating.

9-5-2011 – Patrols responded to Jaycee Park on a report of an unconscious 13-year-old female. While patrols were arriving, approximately 7 juveniles ran from the park. Three other juveniles remained in the park and advised officers that the unconscious female had just consumed a large amount of vodka. The female was treated and transported to Overlook Hospital by the New Providence Rescue Squad. The Juvenile Detective is investigating this case.
