Press Release 9-29-2011

9-15-2011 – Patrolman Michael Scuorzo arrested Ishmeet Arora, 20, of Edison on an outstanding warrant out of Edison Municipal Court. She was initially stopped for motor vehicle violations on Mountain Avenue. Bail was posted and she was released.

9-16-2011 – Patrolman Andrew Diamond charged Joseph Arminio, 57, of Berkeley Heights with driving while intoxicated. The charges stem from a motorist driving behind Mr. Arminio reporting that he was driving carelessly on Springfield Avenue. Mr. Arminio was determined to be intoxicated after an investigation. Mr. Arminio was released to a family member with a pending court date.

9-17-2011 – A 15 year old juvenile was taken into protective custody by officers after a motorist reported that her vehicle had just been struck by objects thrown by the juvenile on Springfield Avenue. The juvenile was released to his parents.

9-23-2011 – Patrolman Chad Wilson charged Michael York, 20, of Summit with driving while intoxicated. The charges stem from Patrolman Wilson stopping Mr. York for motor vehicle violations on Union Avenue and an investigation determining that Mr. York was intoxicated. Mr. York was released to a family member with a pending court date.

9-24-2011- Corporal Dennis Carovillano charged Elizabeth Bartz, 64, of New Providence with driving while intoxicated and careless driving. The charges stem from Corporal Carovillano responding to Hawthorne Drive on a report of a motorist crashing into several parked motor vehicles. Upon his arrival, Elizabeth Bartz was sitting in her vehicle on the front lawn of a residence and began to lose consciousness. First aid was rendered by officers and the New Providence Rescue Squad. She was transported to Overlook Hospital for treatment.

9-25-2011 – Patrolman Andrew Diamond charged David Workman, 50, of Chatham with possession of a controlled dangerous substance. The charge stems from Mr. Workman being stopped on Central Avenue for his vehicle's registration being expired since July of 2010. During the stop, officers detected a smell of burning marijuana coming from his vehicle. Mr. Workman was also charged with possession of drug paraphernalia and operating an unregistered vehicle. Mr. Workman was released with a pending court date.

9-26-2011 – A resident reported getting a scam phone call from someone soliciting funds for the organization “New Jersey Police Officers Foundation” to help pay for police equipment and bullet proof vests. Residents are reminded to research organizations before contributing any donations and to beware of scammers posing as a member of a law enforcement agency. The New Providence Police Department and the New Providence Police Benevolent Association never seek donations via the telephone.

9-27-2011 – Corporal Dennis Carovillano charged Darnell Cooke, 22 , of Chicago, Illinois and Antieneel Mcvey, 25, of Camden with soliciting without a permit. The charges stem from a citizen contacting the police department that the two individuals were going door to door on Jane Road selling merchandise. They were released with a pending court date.
