Press Release: January 18, 2012

01-09-2012- Patrolman Andrew Diamond charged Pyo H. Namkung, age 24, of New Providence with operating a vehicle with a suspended registration after a random license plate inquiry revealed the violation.

01-14-2012- Patrolman Joseph DiParisi arrested Wilfredo Perez-Fuentes, age 23, of West New York on an outstanding warrant out of Flemington Borough after his vehicle was stopped for being overweight on Union Avenue. Mr. Perez-Fuentes was charged with the borough ordinance violation and for operating a vehicle while his license was suspended. He was released pending a court date after bail was posted.

01-14-2012- Patrolman Andrew Diamond arrested Zachary Bence, age 23, of Newark on an outstanding warrant out of the Borough after a random license plate inquiry revealed the active warrant. He was released pending a court date after bail was posted.

01-15-2012- A Borough business reported an incident of shoplifting. Video surveillance has been obtained and the crime is being investigated by the Detective Bureau.
