Press Release: January 26, 2012

01-18-2012- Patrolman Michael Scuorzo charged Cassandra Saul, age 29, of Maplewood with driving while suspended and operating a vehicle without insurance after a random license plate inquiry revealed that her license was suspended.

01-23-2012- A resident responded to police headquarters to report that her son's iPhone was stolen from a locked school locker. Patrols were able to track the phone through the phone's GPS and located it at another juvenile's residence. The phone was returned to the owner and the suspect was released to his mother pending juvenile complaints for the burglary.
