Press Release: February 19, 2013

01-30-2013- Detective Stephen Drown arrested Yue Yang, age 54, of Flushing, NY on an outstanding warrant out of Fort Lee. He was released after posting the bail and an investigation is on-going.

01-31-2013- Patrolman Andrew Diamond arrested Jason D. Hunter, age 26, of New Providence on outstanding warrants out of the borough and Newark. He was released after posting the bail.

01-31-2013- Detective Donald Sretenovic arrested Rebecca Borman, age 20, of New Providence with Insurance Fraud, Theft by Deception, Unsworn Falsification to Authorities, and Hindering Apprehension or Prosecution after an investigation was made into the reported theft of Ms. Borman's vehicle. Ms. Borman reported her vehicle was stolen from her driveway between 6:00 pm on November 22, 2012 and 9:00 am on November 23, 2012. The investigation led to the recovery of Ms. Borman's vehicle in Plainfield. It was left there by Ms. Borman after she was involved in a motor vehicle crash in Madison. Ms. Borman was charged and released pending a court date in Union County.

02-01-2013- A resident of Second Street reported that her ring was stolen from her residence. The theft is being investigated by the New Providence Detective Bureau.

02-05-2013- A resident of South Street reported that he received a phone call from his bank indicating that someone attempted to wire transfer \$9,680.00 from a credit card to his checking account. The victim indicated that he also received several credit cards and bills in the mail that were fraudulent. The victim did not know where his information was stolen from. The identity theft is currently under investigation by the detective bureau.
