Press Release 2-27-2013

2-17-2013 – Patrols responded to Charnwood Road on a report of a motor vehicle being parked on the front lawn of a residence. The vehicle was located without license plates. Patrol officers were able to identify the owner of the vehicle through the vehicle identification number. A summons was issued to Arina Aristova, 43, of New York for abandoning a motor vehicle on private property without license plates.

2-19-2013 – A Southgate Road resident reported that he was having problems with his cellular phone and switched carriers. After receiving his new phone, the former cell phone carrier had contacted him and advised him that someone had opened several accounts and made \$28,000 in fraudulent charges. This matter is under investigation.

2-19-2013 – After several citizen complaints into an unlicensed massage business at 1823 Springfield Avenue, Detectives and the Westfield Regional Board of Health issued several Borough Ordinance violations to the owner of the "Green Spring Spa". The owner of the business, Yue Wu Yang, 54, of Flushing, New York was charged with operating an unlicensed massage business and several other sanitary violations including dirty sheets and towels on massage tables, bacteriostatic solution not available for use for employees before and after services and disinfectant not available for cleaning equipment. Jing Wang, 52, of Flushing, New York was issued a summons for operating as an unlicensed massage therapist.

2-20-2013 – Patrolman David Rodriguez arrested Stephanie Jacobus, 26, of Scotch Plains with attempting to obtain a controlled dangerous substance by fraud and forgery. The charges stem from a report from CVS Pharmacy that she was attempted to fill a fraudulent prescription for Oxycodone. Detectives are investigating a male that was involved in this incident with Ms. Jacobus but fled the scene. During the arrest, a warrant from Bernards Township Municipal Court was located. Ms. Jacobus posted bail and was released with a pending court date.

2-20-2013 – Patrols and the New Providence Fire Department responded to 1141 Springfield Avenue at 8:55 PM on a report of a motor vehicle that had crashed into the residence. Upon arrival, patrols located a 2010 Honda Accord that had significantly damaged the garage portion of the residence. The driver of the vehicle, Steven Careccia, 26, of New Providence was issued a summons for careless driving. No injuries were reported to the driver or the residents of the home.

2-21-2013 – Detective Sean Bubb charged Brooke Eisenberg, 19, of Short Hills with assault by auto after an investigation stemming from a motor vehicle crash on Central Avenue on January 22, 2013 at 4:37 PM. Orville Behm, 75, of Berkeley Heights was critically injured during the crash. With the assistance of the Union County Police Department's Crash Investigation Unit, it was determined that Brooke Eisenberg was traveling east on Central Avenue when she crossed lanes and struck the curb on the west bound side of the roadway. Pieces of Brooke Eisenberg's vehicle and marks on the curb and grass were located by detectives 150 feet prior to the crash scene on the west bound side of the road. As Mr. Behm was traveling west bound on Central Avenue, he swerved in an attempt to avoid Brooke Eisenberg's vehicle but could not avoid the her vehicle. Brooke Eisenberg was also charged with reckless driving and failure to keep right. She was released with a pending court date.

2-26-2013 – Patrolman DiParisi arrested Augustina Almonte, 54, of Bloomfield on outstanding warrants out of Bloomfield and Paterson. The warrants were located during a traffic stop on South Street. She was issued a summons for an equipment violation and for operating an uninsured motor vehicle. She was released after posting bail.
