Press Release: May 14, 2013

04-24-2013- Patrolman Joseph DiParisi arrested Natalie Yang, age 44, of Teaneck on outstanding warrants out of Teaneck and Bergen Central. Ms. Yang's vehicle was stopped after a random license plate inquiry revealed that her license was suspended. Ms. Yang was released after posting bail and charged with operating a vehicle while her license was suspended and for failing to inspect her vehicle.

04-25-2013- Patrolman David Rodriguez arrested David Laconte, age 35, of Phillipsburg on an outstanding warrant out of Clinton Township after he was found trespassing on the property of a Mountain Avenue business. He was released after posting bail.

04-26-2013- Corporal Steven Opalewski charged Norma E. Chambers, age 53, of Springfield with operating a vehicle with a suspended registration after the vehicle was stopped for failing to have the headlights on.

04-27-2013- Patrolman Andrew Diamond arrested Kongting Lee, age 41, of Newark on outstanding warrants out of Newark and Clifton after his vehicle was stopped for not having functioning brake lights. Mr. Lee was turned over to the Clifton Police Department and was issued summonses for failing to produce an insurance card, displaying a fraudulent inspection sticker, and failing to inspect his vehicle.

Mr. Hawrynliuk was also issued a summons for unapproved equipment for the aftermarket muffler.

05-05-2013- Patrolman Andrew Diamond charged Daniel Vandebos, age 27, of New Providence with operating a vehicle while his license was suspended after a random license plate inquiry revealed the violation.

05-06-2013- Corporal Steven Opalewski charged Claudio Romulo Matute Ortiz, age 49, of Baltimore, Maryland with operating a vehicle without insurance after the vehicle he was operating was stopped for commercial lettering violations. Mr. Ortiz was issued for both violations. The registered owner, Julio Espinoza-Palomequ, age 42, of Elizabeth was issued a summons for allowing the operation of a vehicle without insurance. Both were given mandatory court appearances with the New Providence Municipal Court.

05-06-2013- A resident of Crest Road reported incidents of identity theft and fraudulent purchases made using her address along with another victim's name and date of birth from Jersey City. The suspect purchased a motorcycle and ATV in Staten Island utilizing these victims' information. The fraud is currently under investigation by the New Providence and Jersey City Detective Bureaus along with investigators from the Motor Vehicle Commission.

05-09-2013- A resident of Seven Oaks Drive reported several incidents of fraud and identity theft that occurred in Long Island, New York. The resident reported that someone attempted to deposit fraudulent checks into his account and then attempted to have new bank cards shipped to a Long Island address. The resident reported that there were also numerous charges made to other credit cards and the suspect had the resident's calls forwarded to the suspect's phone so any credit card company would contact the suspect in regards to whether or not these purchases were valid. The fraudulent activity is currently under investigation by the detective bureau.

05-10-2013- A resident of Stoneridge Road reported that he was a victim of an overpayment scam. The resident reported that he was selling an item on Craig's List and a potential buyer sent him two money orders for well over the amount that the item was being sold for. The resident was instructed to send back the balance of the money orders after he deposited them into his bank account. The resident deposited the money orders, sent the balance via Western Union to Nigeria, and then shortly afterwards found out the money orders were fraudulent. The victim is currently left having to pay the bank back \$1,600.00 due to the money being lost via Western Union. The fraud is under investigation by the detective bureau.

05-10-2013- Patrolman Michael Hand arrested Freddy Cruz, age 50, of Plainfield on an outstanding warrant out of Clark after his vehicle was stopped for having passenger plates on a commercial vehicle. Mr. Cruz was charged with having passenger plates on a commercial vehicle, operating a vehicle with a suspended registration, operating a vehicle while his license was suspended, failure to change his address, and operating a vehicle without insurance. He was released by Clark pending a court date.

05-11-2013- Patrolman Joseph DiParisi charged Christian Montes, age 27, of Elizabeth with operating a vehicle while his license was suspended and operating an unregistered vehicle after a random license plate inquiry revealed the violations.
