Press Release 5-30-2013

5-22-2013- A juvenile male reported that his iPhone was stolen from a locker at the high school. The detective bureau is investigating this report.

5-22-2013 – A Fairmount Road resident reported several fraudulent charges on his checking account. The fraud was noticed when he went to cash a check at his financial institution. The detective bureau is investigating this report.

5-23-2013 – Detective Bubb charged two Borough juvenile males, 16 and 17 year olds, with possession of under 50 grams of synthetic marijuana, possession of under 50 grams of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia. The charges stem from an investigation from an incident at a Central Avenue address in March.

5-25-2013 – Patrolman Joseph DiParisi was flagged down by an employee of a business at 1260 Springfield Avenue to report shoplifters that were attempting to flee the parking lot. As Patrolman DiParisi stopped his patrol vehicle, one of the suspects attempted to flee the scene by foot and was taken into custody a short distance away from the incident. Ricky Rowell, 42, of Atlantic City was charged with 3rd degree shoplifting for shoplifting 53 items totaling \$881.17. He was released with a pending court date. Further charges are pending from this incident.

5-26-2013 – Patrolman Joseph DiParisi arrested Tauron Manton, 23, of Newark for driving while intoxicated. The charges stem from Patrolman DiParisi observing the vehicle being operated by Mr. Manton in a reckless manner and tailgating on Union Avenue and Pearl Street. He was released to a family member with a pending court date.

5-30-2013 – At 12:09 AM, Patrolman Opalewski was on patrol on Old Springfield Avenue when he heard an alarm sounding from a business. As he approached the business, he observed a shattered front, glass door, and a bicycle lying in front of it. A large rock was located inside the business that was used to have been used to break the window. Patrol units from Summit, Berkeley Heights, Chatham Township, Union County Police Department and the Sheriff's Department K-9 unit set up a perimeter and assisted in locating the suspect on Elkwood Avenue by Sherwood Drive. A 15 year old, juvenile male from Elizabeth, was taken into custody. Charges of burglary, theft and receiving stolen property are pending for the juvenile. He was taken to Overlook Hospital for treatment for injuries he sustained while fleeing through the woods from the scene of the incident.
