Press Release 7-16-2013

6-28-2013 – An Elkwood Avenue resident reported that her smart phone was stolen from a stroller that was left unattended outside of the New Providence Memorial Library.

6-29-2013 – A Third Street resident reported that the driver's side mirror of his vehicle was damaged by a male wearing a helmet that ran away from the property. The damage occurred at 12:30 AM and was observed by the resident after hearing a loud noise coming from outside the residence.

6-29-2013 – A Chatham resident reported that her smart phone was stolen from a shopping cart that she had utilized while shopping at a Springfield Avenue business. Also reported stolen was a Coach wallet that contained personal identification, credit cards, cash and a New Jersey Transit pass. The detective bureau is investigating this report.

6-30-2013 – A Livingston Avenue resident reported that a leaf blower valued at \$300.00 was stolen from the front of his neighbor's garage while he was doing yard work.

6-30-2013 – Patrolman Andrew Diamond charged a 17 year old Berkeley Heights male, with possession of marijuana. He was also charged with failing to yield to a traffic control device and failing to be in possession of the vehicle's registration and insurance card. The juvenile was released to a parent.
