7-29-13 – Patrolman David Rodriguez arrested Alberto Delnegro, 52, of Scotch Plains on outstanding warrants out of Union Township and Fanwood Borough. The warrants were located during a motor vehicle stop on Mountain Avenue. He was released after posting bail.

8-5-13 – Patrols responded to Salt Brook School on a report of criminal mischief. The school administration reported that a newly installed shed was damaged by several juveniles. During the investigation, several juveniles are seen on surveillance footage destroying the shed on July 28<sup>th</sup> at 4:37 PM. Charges are pending upon identification of the juveniles.
