Patrols took a report of a theft of jewelry from an individual at a local business. The complaint reported that the business was in possession of the jewelry of the victim, however, the business has no record of the jewelry in their possession. The Detective Bureau will be investigating this report of theft.

A Borough resident indicated that an unknown person had accessed her checking account and made purchases over \$1100. The victim did not authorize these charges and reported this theft to their banking institution. This matter is being investigated by the New Providence Detective Bureau.

Patrolman TJ Hoppe arrested Adrian Gini of Bedminster, NJ after conducting a motor vehicle stop. During the stop, Officer Hoppe discovered that Ms. Gini was operating her vehicle without a valid driver's license and her vehicle having an expired registration. Ms. Gini also had outstanding warrants from Florham Park and Millburn. Ms. Gini was released on her own recognizance pending her appears in the multiple municipal courts.

On February 23, 2015, Cpl. Sean Bubb stopped Mr. Curt Robley on Mountain Ave, for having a suspended registration. During the course of the motor vehicle stop, it was discovered that the Mr. Robley had several outstanding warrant from South Plainfield and Westfield. When questioned the passenger, Kimberly Mclean about her ability to operate the vehicle, it was discovered that she also had an outstanding warrant out of Westfield. Ms. Mclean was able to post bail on her warrant, however, Mr. Robley was turned over to the custody of South Plainfield Police Department. Mr. Robley was issued multiple summonses for operating vehicle while his license was suspended.
