

TOWN-WIDE BRUSH COLLECTION

As a result of the recent Nor'easter, the Borough Council has authorized a special collection of brush as outlined below.

To allow sufficient time for the snow to melt and time for residents to bring material to the curb, the collection will begin on Monday, March 26, 2018. Everyone must have their brush placed curbside – in accordance with the guidelines below - no later than 6 AM on March 26, 2018. Crews will only be in each area one-time. Please assure that your material is placed at the curb by March 26 at 6 AM.

- No brush larger than 8" in diameter permitted.
- No brush longer than 6 feet.
- Cut end toward street at an angle –



(When facing your house from the street, cut ends go to the left)

- Do Not block sidewalks.
- Do not allow brush to project into the roadway

Several crews will be deployed - beginning on March 26 - starting on the southern (Mountain Avenue) end of town. They will work continuously – weather permitting – toward the northern (Passaic River) end of town.

OTHER OPTIONS:

- Regular weekly brush collection begins on Monday, April 2, 2018 with the following guidelines:
 - Grass clippings, leaves, and small twigs should be placed in open containers no larger than 32 gallons in size. No plastic bags will be accepted.
 - Branches up to four (4) inches in diameter and up to four (4) feet in length **MUST BE TIED AND BUNDLED** and placed at the curb. **ANYTHING EXCEEDING THIS SIZE WILL NOT BE TAKEN.**
 - **NO FIREWOOD, LOGS, TREES, or TREE STUMPS** will be collected.
- You may hire a private tree service to remove trees, branches, brush, debris at your expense
