### Class Descriptions

#### INTRO TO BALLET/TAP (Ages 3-5):

This entry-level class is perfect for your dancer-to-be! Ballet class emphasizes basic ballet terminology, technique, and keeping time with music. In Tap, children learn rhythm, timing, and terminology.

**PLEASE NOTE** – There is NO RECITAL for Wed/Sun Class but family and friends are invited to observe the last class session. RECITAL for Thursday 1:45 class on May 11. Required: Tights, leotard, ballet shoes; black Mary Jane style tap shoes. **Location: Municipal Center Gym.**

#### KIDS CREATIONS/GYM FUN (Ages 4-6):

Two one-hour classes. Children will be in the gym, enjoying fun, cooperative team-based games, relay races and free play. In the other hour, beginning art skills will be cultivated via drawing, painting, cutting and pasting with various materials. **Location: Municipal Center Gym & Art Room.**

**LEGO BUILDING/GYM FUN (Ages 4-6):** Two one-hour classes. During 1<sup>st</sup> hour, children will be in the gym, enjoying fun, cooperative team-based games, relay races and free play. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> class enjoy a hands-on Lego class. See what you can build with Legos. All projects stay in the classroom. **Location: Municipal Center Gym & Art Room.**

**LITTLE PAINTERS/GYM FUN (Ages 4-6):** Two one hour classes. 1<sup>st</sup> hour will be in the gym for fun, team based games and free play. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> class, explore different painting techniques and assorted paint mediums (Watercolor, acrylic, tempera) while using brushes and stamps. **Location: Municipal Center Gym & Art Room.**

**LITTLE SCIENTISTS (Ages 3-5):** Are you raising a Curious Kid? This class will let them explore, ask, discover, experiment and more! Learn basic science concepts in hands-on classes learning environment that celebrates natural curiosity and incorporates a new "experiment" each week. **Location: Art Room.**

#### \*\*\*\*\*NEW THIS SPRING\*\*\*\*\* ANIMAL ADVENTURES/GYM FUN AND GAMES (Ages 4-6):

Two one hour classes. This Animal Adventures art class will make your child want to roar. Each class will learn about different animal and create an art project to go along with the theme. During Gym Fun & Games your child will enjoy aerobic exercise, team based games and free play while enhancing motor skills and physical development (strength, flexibility, coordination and balance). **Location: Municipal Center Gymnasium/Art Room.**

**LITTLE ASTRONAUTS (Ages 3-5):** Blast Off!! A fun and sensory based science class focusing on the solar system, space and astronauts. This class will use different items to mimic atmosphere, temperature and gravity. Your child will learn about the planets, the moon and rocket ships. By the end of class, students will have created a model of the solar system. Instructor: Diane Pereira. **Location: Art Room**

**THE SCIENCE OF ART/GYM CLIMBING (Ages 3-4):** In the 1<sup>st</sup> hour climb over mats and under bridges, through tunnels and around obstacles. Children will complete obstacle courses, play hide and find and enjoy a treasure hunt. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> hour children will create art work with a science twist. What does salt to watercolor paint? What happens to paint when we add sand? Instructor: Diane Pereira. **Location: Art Room/Gym**
