

# New Providence Park Rules

In accordance with Executive Order No. 133 New Providence offers the following guidance concerning our parks. As New Jersey makes continued progress in its fight against COVID-19, it is appropriate to ensure that New Providence residents can safely enjoy outdoor recreation, with reasonable restrictions. These are designed to limit the spread of COVID-19 and as a way to enhance physical and mental health, while maintaining the overall social distancing and mitigation requirements in place to protect the health, safety, and welfare of our community.

## REMAINING CLOSED

- ✗ BASKETBALL/TENNIS

Employees and visitors should wear cloth face coverings while in the Park in all settings where other social distancing measures are difficult to maintain, except where doing so would inhibit that individual's health or where the individual is under two years of age

No picnicking shall be allowed, including on picnic blankets in signed picnic areas, and no picnic blankets, chairs, coolers, and other such personal property shall be carried into any New Providence park.

No organized or contact sports or activities shall be allowed.
