

## TryCAN Pioneer Playground Camp

TryCAN Pioneer Playground Camp will provide opportunities for kids with special needs to be have fun while increasing self-esteem and confidence. Activities will be similar to those in typical day-camps but will focus on social interaction, sensory integration, coordination, sequencing, creativity and following direction. Two certified special education teachers will oversee the camp with support from staff and trained peer mentors. Participants will be grouped according to age and ability.

The center/station approach will provide daily options to explore activities in arts and crafts to develop fine motor skills, sports, dance and other physical activities to develop gross motor skills, games for socialization and playground play for general development and exploration.

Class size is limited to 6 children.
