SUMMER S.T.E.A.M. ACADEMY - CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING I - Saving Lives: Grades 5-7. Weeks 1 and 3. 9:00-10:30am. Weeks 2 and 4. 10:30am-Noon. \$75/week. - *What is biomedical engineering? - How do biomedical engineers help save human lives? - How do biomedical engineers help people live a better life?* These are just some of the questions that students will delve into during this hands-on workshop as they engage in a variety of engineering design challenges based on the human body. Students may design a more effective method for getting medicine into the body, replicate how to create an artificial organ, design a brace for an injured joint, or show how face transplants have recently developed. Please note - not all challenges may be completed over the week and may vary by class and available resources. *Mr. Keaney*

BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING II - The Heart is a Wonderful Machine: Grades 5-7. Weeks 1 and 3. 10:30am-Noon. Weeks 2 and 4. 9:00-10:30am. \$75/week. - *How does the heart work? - Why does the heart sometimes stop working? - How can biomedical engineers help save the lives of people with heart disease?* These are just some of the questions that students will delve into during this hands-on workshop as they conduct an in-depth study of the human heart, examine heart disease, design heart valves and identify healthy heart lifestyle choices. Please note - students do not have to have attended Biomedical Engineering I to enroll in this workshop. *Mr. Keaney*

DIY GAMING: Grades 3-5. Week 1. 9:00-10:00am. Week 3. 10:00am-11:00am \$50/week. Do you like to play games? What if you could make your own games? Now you can! Program Overview

The New Providence Recreation Department conducts swimming lessons at the New Providence Community Pool (NPCP). Non-residents (including non-resident NPCP members) may register beginning June 11, 2018, if space permits. **This is a drop-off program. Community Pool regulations prohibit parents from being in the pool area during swim lessons provided by the recreation department. Please do not register for this program if you are not comfortable with your child being in the water without you.** Parents should register swimmers by skill level, i.e. **Beginner or Intermediate. In order to provide adequate instruction for all participants, registration will be limited for all time slots.**

Swimmers are assessed and grouped by the ability levels on the first day of each two-week session by the instructors. Instruction begins on day two of each session. Beginner swimmers can expect their instructor in the water with them at all times. For intermediate swimmers, the instructor will be in the water for demonstration purposes and other times when the swimmers need support.

On the first day of each session, parents will receive a form with their child's placement level and the list of skills to be covered. An evaluation form will be given at the end of each session.

Lessons will not be held in the event of heavy rain, thunder & lightening. The recreation department updates the Weather Hotline, (908)464-0600, first with weather related cancellations and will then send out emails to participants.
