With reference to the above captioned project, I hereby transmit Project Change Order (No. 1 and Final) in the deduct amount of (-) \$208.00 and Final Payment in the amount of \$7,890.74 for approval through Resolution by the Mayor and Council. Arnold's Roads Inc. has completed the entire project including the site clearing, curbing, asphalt driveways, concrete driveways and sidewalks, landscaping and traffic markings from 37 to 65 Division Avenue and Maser Consulting has verified that all punchlist items have been completed.

The original contract amount was \$38,735.50 and total cost of this change to the contract is minus \$250.00 resulting in a decrease. The amended contract amount is \$38,527.50 including deduct Change Order #1.
