TITLE: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION BY PUBLIC SALE OF
MULCH NOT NEEDED FOR A PUBLIC PURPOSE

Councilperson Gennaro submitted the following resolution, which was duly seconded by Councilperson Muñoz.

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Providence has accumulated a large supply of mulch as a result of Hurricane Sandy: and

WHEREAS, the mulch exceeds the amount necessary to satisfy the needs of the Borough of New Providence allowing for the opportunity sell excess the mulch, and the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq., permits the sale of personal property not needed for public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Providence, in the County of Union and State of New Jersey, that they do hereby authorize the Borough Clerk and the Manager of the Department of Public Works to sell the mulch at \$10.00 per cubic yard, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, consumers must pick up the mulch at the time designated by the Manager of the Department of Public Works from the Grove Terrace Field. Individual purchases may not exceed 250 Cubic Yards.
