TITLE RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF MASER
CONSULTING P.A. FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES
FOR THE OAKWOOD DRIVE – SECTION 2 PROJECT

Councilperson Lesnewich submitted the following resolution, which was duly
seconded by Councilperson Munoz.

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Providence has a need to acquire Professional
Engineering Services as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of
N.J.S.A. 19-44A-20.5; and

WHEREAS, Maser Consulting P.A. has submitted a proposal dated February 4,
2013 indicating they will provide professional engineering relating to the Oakwood Drive
– Section 2 Project, for an amount not to exceed \$13,500.00; and

WHEREAS, Maser Consulting was awarded a contract with the Borough of New
Providence via Resolution 2011-23, and fees assessed with this project are contained in
said contract; and

WHEREAS Maser Consulting has completed and submitted a Business Entity
Disclosure Certificate which certifies that Maser Consulting has not made any reportable
contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Borough of New Providence in
the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit Maser Consulting from making
any reportable contributions through the term of the contract, and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount of the contract is not to exceed \$13,500.00,
and said funds are available and have been certified by the Chief Financial Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5) requires that the
resolution authorizing and awarding of contracts for "professional services" without
competitive bids and the contract itself must be available for public inspection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Providence that they hereby agree as follows:

1. The Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached agreement with Maser Consulting for Professional Engineering and Inspection Services.
2. Such contract is awarded without competitive bids as a "professional service" in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1) (a) of the Local Public Contracts Law, because the services to be rendered are professional in nature and are unspecifiable as to requirements for performance. Such services must be rendered by a person particularly trained and licensed in this area, which requires extensive specific education and long experience in both the Federal and State procedural requirements.
3. A notice of this action shall be published once in the Courier News.

Maser Consulting P.A. (Maser Consulting) is pleased to present this proposal for engineering design services regarding the Roadway Improvements to Oakwood Drive - Section 2, NJDOT Local Aid Project. Maser Consulting will provide the following services:

PHASE I SCOPE OF WORK AND SERVICES - DESIGN:

Maser Consulting will provide design services for the Borough of New Providence Local Aid Project known as Roadway Improvements to Oakwood Drive - Section 2. The project shall begin at Mountain Avenue and extend to South Street. The project limits shall be adjusted in order to remain within the project budget. Maser Consulting shall prepare the base mapping, title sheet, general notes and legend, estimate of quantities, construction plans, soil erosion and sediment control plans and the construction details. A check against the existing tax maps will be made to ensure the road map contains the most recent road data, based on recent subdivisions and road alignment data.

Maser Consulting shall also prepare the supplemental and technical specifications for the proposed improvements that are specified on our construction drawings for incorporation into the overall bid specifications. The specifications will be prepared in the latest NJDOT format, as amended.

Please note that alternate bids shall be utilized in order for the project to remain within the Borough's budget. Maser Consulting will finalize the Construction Cost Estimate (CCE) based on the quantity required for each alternate bid. On behalf of the Borough, Maser Consulting shall submit all plans and specifications to the NJDOT Local Aid offices and the Union County Soil Conservation District for review and approval.

Upon acceptance of the project by NJDOT Local Aid and the Union County Soil Conservation District, Maser Consulting will furnish the Borough with four (4) signed and sealed complete sets of bid documents.

It is our understanding that the project is funded jointly by the NJDOT Local Aid grant of \$205,000 and the Borough.



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PHASE II BIDDING SERVICES:

Maser Consulting will coordinate with the Borough regarding the Bidding Services; specifically the following shall be conducted:

- Schedule the advertisement for bid (Notice to Bidder)
- Attend a Pre-Bid Conference to discuss Construction Documents with perspective bidders, as required.
- Development of addendum(s) to clarify or review the bid documents, as required.
- Attend bid opening and reading of bids in order to tabulate them.
- Review the proposals from the responsive bidders and make recommendations to the Borough regarding the selection and evaluation of the bids.

The following is the estimated schedule for the project:

(Upon receipt of bids, a separate proposal for inspection services shall be submitted to the Borough for their review and approval.)

FEE PROPOSAL

Based on the above referenced information, Maser Consulting will provide the above referenced services for a cost not to exceed \$ 13,500.00.

The above design and bidding services will be provided on a cost basis not to exceed the listed amount. The hourly rate schedule and services required will be performed in accordance with the Borough Engineering Contract authorized by the Borough of New Providence.



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EXCLUSIONS

If any item listed herein, or otherwise not specifically mentioned within this agreement or the Borough Engineering Agreement, is deemed necessary, then Maser Consulting may prepare an addendum to this agreement for your review, outlining the scope of additional services and associated professional fees with regard to the extra work. All unanticipated additional work shall be in accordance with the Schedule of Hourly Rates that has been previously approved by the Borough. Maser Consulting shall provide a separate proposal for on-site inspection and coordination with the NJDOT for project closeout. No extra work will be performed without authorization from the Borough.

If you find this proposal acceptable, please forward a copy of the Resolution of Approval for this proposal to this office. This will constitute approval of the proposed work.
