AGREEMENT

This Agreement between the Borough of New Providence (“Borough”) and the City of Summit (“City”) dated this _____ of June 2013.

W I T N E S S E T H

Whereas, the Borough of New Providence engaged Maser Consulting to design the sidewalk installation under the Safe Routes to School grant program; and

Whereas, the Borough is required by the New Jersey Department of Transportation (“NJDOT”) to have independent inspections during construction of the project; and

Whereas, the City of Summit agrees to provide full-time construction inspection services for the project through its Engineering Department, which has the licensed professional personnel to provide such services;

Now, therefore, the Borough and the City hereby agree as follows:

1. The City will provide the Borough with full-time construction inspection services for the sidewalk installation under the Safe Routes to School grant program in the Borough through its Engineering Department.
2. The City will prepare and file all necessary reports of the inspection services provided to the Borough with such agencies as may be required in accordance with the grants received by the Borough and the applicable rules and regulations of the appropriate agency, including without limitation, the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
3. In consideration of the services to be provided by the City, the Borough agrees to pay the City the sum of \$_____ per hour for time spent by its inspectors on the project. Services shall be billed by the City no more frequently than monthly.
4. The City shall not be considered an agent or employee of the Borough and shall be fully responsible for the payment of its employees and shall provide all insurance coverage for this service, including without limitation workers compensation insurance.

This agreement shall become effective upon the approval of the New Providence Borough Council and the City Council of Summit.
