As you are aware our recycling contract is up at the end of the year. I got one price of \$198,000 from Suburban Disposal and Giordano price started at \$143,000. I was able to get him down to \$107,250 for a 1 year contract. Our current contract with Giordano is \$89,400 which hasn't increased since 2013.

The reason for such a large increase is due to the fact that the market is down on recycling material. When the market was higher they were able to give us a better price because they keep the revenue from the material recycled.
