Re: Verizon 9-1-1 Trunks

With the consolidation of the three municipalities into one local PSAP we need to reallocate our 9-1-1 trunks. Based on historical data provided by the New Jersey Office of Emergency Telecommunications and Verizon we will require six (6) 9-1-1 trunks.

We will redirect the four (4) existing 9-1-1 trunks for New Providence and require the addition of two (2) more for a total of six (6).

Attached is the proposal from Verizon for the install of the new 9-1-1 circuits.

Action required: Approval of Verizon's proposal for the additional 9-1-1 trunks in the amount of \$4,600.00. Funding for this proposal would be through existing capital funds for the consolidated communication center project.
