TITLE: Resolution Prohibiting The Treatment, Storage And Disposal Of Wastewater Byproducts Resulting From Hydraulic Fracturing Within The Boundaries Of The Borough Of New Providence”

Councilperson Galluccio submitted the following resolution, which was duly seconded by Councilperson Gennaro.

WHEREAS, the "fracking" drilling technique uses vast quantities of water at high pressure to fracture the shale formation and millions of gallons of water flow back out of the well, and

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Providence discourages the treatment, discharge, disposal, application to roadway, or storage of wastewater, wastewater solids, sludge, drill cuttings or other byproducts from natural gas exploration or production using hydraulic fracturing within the boundaries of the Borough of New Providence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of New Providence, in the County of Union hereby adopts this resolution to affirm their collective opposition to the above conditions.
