TITLE RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INVESTIGATIVE STUDIES TO BE
PERFORMED BY MASER CONSULTING RELATED TO THE
RIVERWALK PROJECT

Councilperson Galluccio submitted the following resolution, which was duly
seconded by Councilperson Muñoz .

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Providence desires to have studies performed to determine the feasibility of the Downtown River Walk project. The area to be studied is located to the west of properties along the west side of South Street, from Springfield Avenue to Gales Drive.

WHEREAS, A Preliminary Assessment is required where Maser's environmental expert will review the available mapping and perform a site walk. Information gathered would be evaluated in the context of the proposed improvements. Approximate cost \$2,500.

WHEREAS, if the project or portions of the project appear to be permitted, Maser would recommend moving to step 2. Step 2 shall consist of a Pre-application Meeting with the NJDEP – Utilizing the “Connected Community” Concept; Maser would prepare a basic concept sketch of the specific area in question, depicting the proposed improvements with approximate limits of improvements and disturbance. Maser would coordinate and attend a meeting with NJDEP representatives to present the project in a conceptual nature to determine the scope, timing and cost of NJDEP permitting. Approximate cost of \$2,750; and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount of the contract is not to exceed \$5,250.00, and said funds are available from the following account: 15—268-968-4-42001 and have been certified by the Chief Financial Officer; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Providence that they hereby authorize the feasibility studies as outlined above.
