WHEREAS, Sealed Bids Were Received On Wednesday, May 13, 2015 for the Central Avenue and Maple Street Intersection Signal Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received; and

WHEREAS, all bids exceeded the budgeted amount for the project were therefor rejected; and

WHEREAS, the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council awarded a contract to Jen Electric Inc, Contract #37 – Traffic Signal Maintenance and Repairs; and

WHEREAS, Jen Electric, Inc. has submitted a proposal dated June 3, 2015, for the Central Avenue and Maple Street Intersection Signal Improvements in accordance with the documents and plans prepared by Maser Consulting, P.A., and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer, Maser Consulting, has reviewed proposal from Jen Electric, inc. and recommends the contract be awarded to same, subject to review of bid documents by the borough Attorney; and

WHEREAS, Funding for the project is available in the following capital accounts:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of New Providence, County of Union and State of New Jersey, that the contract for the Central Avenue and Maple Street Intersection Signal Improvements

The bid opening for the above-referenced project was held on Wednesday, May 13, 2015 at 11:00 am with the Engineer Representative, Paul Niehoff, and Wendi Barry, Borough Clerk present. Bids were received from three (3) contractors.

The low bid was received from Tiffany Electric, Inc., in the amount of \$156,153.75. Based on a review of the summary of bids, alternates, contract documents, and contractor references, it is our recommendation that the Borough reject the three received bids. It is our recommendation that the Borough award this contract to Jen Electric Inc. under the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council in the amount of \$131,546.00., for the above-referenced project. Award of the contract would be subject to the following conditions:

- The Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council is responsible for the performance bond;
- Jen Electric is responsible for clearing site per their submitted quote;
- Jen Electric is responsible for traffic control per their submitted quote;
- The Borough will provide Police Traffic Directors, if necessary. This will be determined by the Chief of Police and the Borough Administrator.

Award would be subject to review of the bid documents by the Borough Attorney and the availability of funds. Copies of the Bid Summary and quote from Jen Electric are enclosed.
