TITLE: RESOLUTION AMENDING THE EXISTING MUNICIPAL 911 PLAN FOR THE BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE TO REFLECT THE OPERATION OF THE SHARED DISPATCH CENTER.

Councilperson Kapner submitted the following resolution, which was duly seconded by Councilperson Muñoz.

Whereas, by virtue of the implementation and operation of the Shared Dispatch center for New Providence Summit and Millburn, the governing body of the Borough of New Providence hereby amends the existing Municipal 9-1-1 Plan to reflect the following:

1. The 9-1-1 calls for the Borough of New Providence will be answered by the Mountain Valley Emergency Communications Center (NPSM Emergency Services Dispatch Center, a Joint Meeting in the State of New Jersey) PSAP.
2. The Borough of New Providence will not maintain the enhanced 9-1-1 equipment for the purpose of receiving 9-1-1 transfers from the Mountain Valley Emergency Communications Center (NPSM Emergency Services Dispatch Center, a Joint Meeting in the State of New Jersey) PSAP.
3. All calls requiring Police Dispatch will be dispatched by the Mountain Valley Emergency Communications Center (NPSM Emergency Services Dispatch Center, a Joint Meeting in the State of New Jersey) PSAP.
4. All calls requiring Fire Dispatch will be dispatched by the Mountain Valley Emergency Communications Center (NPSM Emergency Services Dispatch Center, a Joint Meeting in the State of New Jersey) PSAP.
5. All calls requiring EMS Dispatch will be dispatched by the Mountain Valley Emergency Communications Center (NPSM Emergency Services Dispatch Center, a Joint Meeting in the State of New Jersey) PSAP.
6. Emergency Medical Dispatchers (EMD) at the Mountain Valley Emergency Communications Center (NPSM Emergency Services Dispatch Center, a Joint

Meeting in the State of New Jersey) PSAP will be responsible for all medical emergency call dispatch decisions and providing Pre-Arrival instructions to callers.

Now, therefore, be it resolved the Borough of New Providence authorizes these changes to be effective as of 07-31-2015 at 0800 hours.
