TITLE: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A PLENARY RETAIL CONSUMPTION LICENSE TO MURRAY HILL & LICENSE SERVICES, LLC.

Councilperson Galluccio submitted the following resolution, which was duly seconded by Councilperson Muñoz.

WHEREAS, an application was made to be awarded a plenary retail consumption license to be issued by the Borough of New Providence to Murray Hill and License Services, LLC, an affiliate of Murray Hill Inn Associates, LP t/a Best Western Plus Murray Hill Hotel and Suites (hereinafter "Murray Hill"); and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on June 22, 2016 concerning the application for the issuance of a license; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has considered the application and presentation of Murray Hill and after consideration of all factors relevant to the issuance of a liquor license, having determined that the issuance of such license to Murray Hill is in the best public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Borough of New Providence, County of Union, State of New Jersey that a plenary retail consumption license is hereby authorized to be issued to Murray Hill, conditioned upon payment of \$55,000.00, representing fifty percent (50%) of the amount offered by Murray Hill for payment of such license, and further conditioned upon the satisfactory conclusion of any and all investigations and satisfactory completion of any and all applications to the State of New Jersey and approval by the State. Payment referenced herein shall be held in escrow by the Borough. Murray Hill may withdraw its application within 120 days of passage of this Resolution, and all funds paid will be refunded. The balance of the amount offered for payment for the license will be paid to prior to issuance of the license.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
