Re: Purchase of One Ford Interceptor SUV Police Vehicle

I am writing this letter to advise you of the purchase of one 2017 Ford Interceptor AWD SUV Police Vehicle. The vehicle will be purchased from Beyer Ford, 170 Ridgedale Ave Morristown, NJ. The purchase price for the vehicle is \$27,477.50. It would be purchased through the Morris County Co-op, under contact number 15A, item number 5. The request for this vehicle is to replace a current patrol car that will be moved down to the traffic division. I am also respectfully requesting to add one additional vehicle to our fleet. We had an undercover Chevrolet Trailblazer that was used as vehicle 951 and now that vehicle is no longer able to be used. That vehicle will be sold at auction in the near future. I would like to keep the current police administrations Dodge Charger in lieu of the undercover vehicle and would like to add one additional vehicle to our fleet. With our department currently staffed at twenty five sworn officers, there will be five officers in the Detective/Traffic Bureau sharing two police vehicles. As Officers have different cases and assignments, it has proven to be difficult for four officers to share two vehicles. I suspect a fifth officer will only increase the burden. Thank you for your attention in this matter.
