CONSULTING, P.A. FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES
REGARDING STORM SEWER OUTFALL & STORMWATER FACILITY
INSPECTIONS

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Providence acquired Professional Engineering
and Professional Environmental Consulting Services as a non-fair and open contract
pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19-44A-20.5; and

WHEREAS, Maser Consulting was awarded a contract with the Borough of New
Providence via Resolution 2017-018 to provide professional engineering services; and

WHEREAS, Maser Consulting Services has submitted a proposal dated March 1,
2018 indicating they will provide professional engineering services specific to the Teir
A – Stormwater General Permit, Storm Sewer Outfall & Stormwater Facility Inspections,
for an amount not to exceed \$12,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the fees assessed with this proposal are contained in said contract;
and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount of the proposal is not to exceed \$12,000.00,
and said funds are available from the following accounts:

Dear Mr. Marvin:

Periodically, the Borough of New Providence is required to perform inspections of all stormwater outfalls. This is a requirement of the Borough of New Providence's Tier A - Stormwater General Permit (PI ID#: 214933). The Borough previously performed these inspections in 2017. As of January 1, 2018, the Stormwater Discharge General Permit Requirements have been updated and require inspections of all Municipal Stormwater Facilities as well (see attached pages 17 & 18 of the NJDEP Tier A Municipal General Permit).

The purpose of the outfall inspections is to verify the physical condition of the outfalls (deterioration or scour) and to determine if there are any illicit connections (flow other than stormwater) into the Borough Storm Sewer System. The Borough of New Providence has 164 Storm Sewer Outfalls.

The purpose of the stormwater facility inspections is to ensure adequate long-term cleaning, operation, and maintenance of all municipally owned or operated stormwater facilities. Stormwater facilities include catch basins, detention basins, retention basins, filter strips, riparian buffers, infiltration trenches, sand filters, constructed wetlands, wet basins, bioretention systems, low flow bypasses, and stormwater conveyances. The Borough of New Providence has four (4) detention basins. Access to the detention basins may potentially be an issue.

As discussed, Maser Consulting will perform the Storm Sewer Outfall and Stormwater Facility Inspections for a cost not to exceed \$12,000.00. Maser Consulting will invoice the project at the hourly rates established in our 2018 Borough Engineering contract.
