TITLE: RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL, BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE ACKNOWLEDGING GRANT AWARD FOR PEDESTRIAN SAFETY FROM THE STREET SMART NJ PROGRAM.

Councilperson Madden submitted the following resolution, which was duly seconded by Councilperson Geoffroy.

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Providence supports the grant application made to the New Jersey Division of Highway Traffic Safety (NJDHTS) for the Street Smart NJ Program. The grant will help implement programs designed to reduce motor vehicle crashes, injuries, and fatalities on New Providence roads. New Providence will coordinate the Street Smart campaign with TransOptions, a non-profit that brings free programs to municipalities to enhance mobility and quality of life, to educate and raise public awareness of safe driving and walking.

WHEREAS, the New Providence Police Department will use NJDHTS grant funding to increase pedestrian safety enforcement to address specific, local traffic safety issues.

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Providence experienced 13 pedestrian-related crashes from 2014 to 2016. The Borough recognizes that New Jersey has been designated a "focus state" by the Federal Highway Administration and Boonton recognizes its role in the statewide goal in preventing crashes involving pedestrians.

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Providence will combine enforcement with education and outreach efforts to promote positive behaviors from people walking and driving in New Providence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the New Providence Police Department has been awarded a grant by the New Jersey Division of Highway Traffic Safety and the Borough of New Providence agrees to accept the grant award. The Borough of New Providence will comply with all applicable laws, requirements and regulations as stated in the grant agreement, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Borough Council of the Borough of New Providence names the fiscal agent for the Borough of New Providence for this project as: Douglas R. Marvin, Borough Administrator
