TITLE RESOLUTION APPROVING REQUEST NEW PROVIDENCE
SUSTAINABILITY COMMITTEE TO HOST A FREE CYCLE EVENT ON
SEPTEMBER 29, 2018

WHEREAS, New Providence Sustainability Committee recently conducted a survey of the community to determine whether there would be interest in a free-cycle event, where residents could bring their unwanted items to a central location in New Providence and offer them for “recycling” to other families, and

WHEREAS, unwanted material at the end of the event will be removed and disposed of or recycled by the borough.

WHEREAS, the response from the community demonstrated strong support of this type of event; and,

WHEREAS, the committee received approval from the American Legion to use their property for the event.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Providence that they hereby approve the request the Sustainability Committee to host their FreecycleFest event on Saturday, September 29, 2018 and express their appreciation to the committee and the American Legion for their efforts to make this event possible.

The Sustainability Committee conducted a community wide survey to gauge the level of interest in a free-cycle event to be hosted by the Sustainability Committee. The response was overwhelmingly positive.
