ALLIANCE FOR THE YEAR 2019-2020

Councilperson Muñoz submitted the following resolution, which was duly seconded by

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse established the Municipal Alliances for the Prevention of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government and law enforcement officials, schools, nonprofit organizations, the faith community, parents, youth and other allies in efforts to prevent alcoholism and drug abuse in communities throughout New Jersey.

WHEREAS, The New Providence Council of the Borough of New Providence, County of Union, State of New Jersey recognizes that the abuse of alcohol and drugs is a serious problem in our society amongst persons of all ages; and therefore has an established Municipal Alliance Committee; and,

WHEREAS, the New Providence Borough Council further recognizes that it is incumbent upon not only public officials but upon the entire community to take action to prevent such abuses in our community; and,

WHEREAS, the New Providence Borough Council has applied for funding to the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse through the County of Union;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough of New Providence, County of Union, State of New Jersey hereby recognizes the following:

1. The New Providence Borough Council does hereby authorize submission of a strategic plan for the New Providence Municipal Alliance grant for fiscal year July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020 in the amount of:

2. The New Providence Borough Council acknowledges the terms and conditions for administering the Municipal Alliance grant, including the administrative compliance and audit requirements.

RE: FY 2020 Alliance Funding

Dear Mayor Morgan,

On behalf of the Local Advisory Committee on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (LACADA) and the Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders, I am pleased to inform you that your Municipal Alliance Program has been awarded Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 Alliance funding in the amount of \$16,867 for the 12 month period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. This grant requires a 25% cash match and a 75% in-kind match as detailed below:

DEDR Award	\$ 16,867
Cash Match	\$ 4,217
In-Kind Match	\$ 12,650

In FY 2015, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse, (GCADA) began a 5 year grant cycle that will cover FY 2015 through FY 2019. FY 2020 has been included as an extension year of the cycle. In continuation of this grant cycle, GCADA recommended that every Municipal Alliance in the county have funding allocated through a formula-based funding allocation process. Municipalities were awarded based upon their municipal population, youth population, Alcohol and Drug related crime and treatment statistics as well as 2009-2012 Alliance grant compliance. Your FY 2020 award is consistent with last year's award.

Please bear in mind that your FY 2020 award is contingent upon funding availability and approval of the grantor, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (GCADA) and the Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders (BCF), as well as current subcontract compliance. The Union County BCF are anticipated to approve the FY 2020 Municipal Alliance grant awards at their 11/29/18 meeting.
