All other classified positions in the Borough of New Providence shall be Compensated in accordance with the rates of compensation established by Ordinance 2019-13 entitled "An Ordinance Fixing the Minimum and Maximum Rates of Compensation for Certain Offices and Positions of Employment Established and Maintained In and For the Borough of New Providence" and shall be paid on a bi-monthly basis or in such manner as shall be further ordered.
