TITLE: RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE INSERTION OF ANY SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE IN THE 2020 BUDGET PURSUANT OF N.J.S. 40A:4-87 CHAPTER 159, P.L. 1948, FY2020 MUNICIPAL ALLIANCE FUNDING EXTENSION

Councilperson Cumiskey submitted the following resolution, which was duly seconded by Councilperson Matsikoudis.

WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the Budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the Budget; and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of any item of appropriation for equal amount.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of New Providence, County of Union and State of New Jersey, hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Service to approve the insertion of item of revenue in the Budget of 2020 in the sum of \$837.80, which item is now available as revenue from the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse and the Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that that a like sum, be and the same is hereby appropriated under the captions of:

FY2020 Municipal Alliance	\$ 837.80

**RE: FY2020 Alliance Funding Extension - 5<sup>th</sup> Quarter**

Dear Mayor Morgan,

Due to the COVID-19 Fiscal Mitigation Act signed by Governor Murphy, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (GCADA) has extended the Municipal Alliance Program Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 to include a 5<sup>th</sup> quarter. The 5<sup>th</sup> quarter extension is for the three (3) month period of July 1, 2020 through September 30, 2020. Your Municipal Alliance Program has been awarded FY2020 Drug Education Demand Reduction (DEDR) 5<sup>th</sup> quarter extension funding in the amount of \$837.80 for *Coordination only*. Below outlines your award to date:

7/1/2019-6/30/2020	\$16,867.00	All DEDR activities & coordination.
7/1/2020-9/30/2020	\$837.80	DEDR coordination only.
<b>Total Award:</b>	<b>\$17,704.80</b>	

There is a programmatic freeze on DEDR expenses from March 23, 2020 through September 30, 2020. *If a municipality chooses to still run programs, they can do so using Cash Match or fundraised funding, so long as it follows DEDR guidelines. The DEDR freeze mentioned above does not include Coordinator's salary for FY2020 fourth quarter and the fifth quarter extension. The 5<sup>th</sup> quarter extension will still require a 25% Cash Match and 75% In-Kind Match as detailed below:*

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
Should the municipality accept this fifth quarter award, please submit a revised Form 6, revised Form 8, and a Budget Modification. **This will need to be submitted by July 22, 2020.** In addition, please note the closeout report for the 5<sup>th</sup> quarter will be due October 16, 2020. All expenses must be paid, not encumbered before submitting the closeout report for reimbursement to the County. No reimbursement of expenditures will be approved until the Municipal Alliance has submitted amended documentation for the extension period.

As a result of the FY2020 extension, FY2021 will now only have three (3) quarters, beginning on October 1, 2020 and ending on June 30, 2021.

Please bear in mind that your FY2020 award is contingent upon funding availability and approval of the grantor, GCADA and the Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders (BCF), as well as current subcontract compliance. The FY 2020 Municipal Alliance grant award extensions will be presented at the BCF 7/23/2020 meeting for approval.
