TITLE RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH COUNTY OF UNION TO INSTALL RECTANGULAR RAPID FLASHING BEACONS (RRFB) AND IN-PAVEMENT TRAFFIC CROSSWALK LED AT THE INTERSECTION OF SPRINGFIELD AVENUE AND ACADEMY STREET

Councilperson Cumiskey submitted the following resolution, which was duly seconded by Councilperson Matsikoudis.

WHEREAS, In an effort to increase pedestrian safety, the Borough of New Providence, desires to install a rectangular rapid flashing beacon (RRFB) and in-pavement traffic crosswalk led on Springfield Avenue at the intersection of Academy Street; and

WHEREAS, the above location has high pedestrian volume and the County of Union concurs that these locations would be ideal for the installation of RFPB; and

WHEREAS, because the proposed location is along a County road, the County of Union requested an agreement to permit the installation of the RRFB and in-pavement traffic crosswalk led at the Springfield Avenue and Academy Street location; and

WHEREAS, the County of Union, in discharge of its public duties, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-120.1 desires to permit the Borough of New Providence to install the RRFB as identified herein; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Providence has agreed to install RRFB and in-pavement traffic crosswalk led at Springfield Avenue and Academy Street and to be responsible for any and all costs or expenses associated with same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of New Providence that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to request and execute an agreement with the County of Union in which the Borough agrees to install one RRFB and in-pavement traffic crosswalk led at the intersection of Springfield Avenue and Academy Street and will be responsible for any and all costs or expenses associated with same.
