Councilperson Muñoz submitted the following resolution, which was duly seconded by Councilperson DeSarno.

WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the Budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the Budget; and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of any item of appropriation for equal amount.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of New Providence, County of Union and State of New Jersey, hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Service to approve the insertion of item of revenue in the Budget of 2020 in the sum of \$5,555.00, which item is now available as revenue from the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse and the Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that that a like sum, be and the same is hereby appropriated under the captions of:

RE: FY 2021 Alliance Funding

Dear Mayor Morgan,

Due to the significant decrease in Drug Enforcement Demand Reduction (DEDR) Fund collections, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (GCADA) has announced a reduction to the previously awarded Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 Municipal Alliance Program. The Governor has also extended the state budget for FY 2020 to include an additional quarter ending on September 30, 2020, and shortened FY 2021 to nine (9) months beginning on October 1, 2020 and ending on June 30, 2021. The GCADA therefore has provided a revised grant award to Union County for the FY 2021 Municipal Alliance Program.

As a result, Union County has revised the allocation for FY 2021 per the CASS and LACADA approved funding formula. Your Municipal Alliance Program has been awarded a revised FY 2021 DEDR funding in the amount of \$5,555.00 for the period of October 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. This grant requires a 25% Cash Match and a 75% In-Kind Match as detailed below:

DEDR Award	\$5,555.00
Cash Match	\$1,388.75
In-Kind Match	\$4,166.25

The following revised forms are to be submitted to the County Alliance Coordinator no later than August 17, 2020.

- Form 1A – Strategic Plan for Funding Municipal Alliances
- Form 1B – Resolution
- Form 6 – Alliance Coordination Plan
- Form 7 – Alliance Action Plan(s)
- Form 8 – Alliance Budget

In FY 2021, the GCADA will begin a four (4) year grant cycle that will cover FY 2021 through 2025. In this new grant cycle, GCADA recommended that every Municipal Alliance in the county have funding through a formula-based funding



allocation process. Municipalities were awarded based upon their municipal population, youth population, Alcohol and Drug related crime and treatment statistics, as well as 2016-2019 Alliance grant compliance. The funds allocated for the non-participating municipalities were distributed as Hold Harmless funding to the top nine Alliances in the compliance rating that were receiving decreases.

Please bear in mind that your FY 2021 award is contingent upon funding availability and approval of the grantor, the GCADA, and the Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders (BCF), as well as current subcontract compliance. It is anticipated that the Union County BCF will approve the revised FY 2021 Municipal Alliance spending plan at their 8/13/2020 meeting.
